

# Get going with cloudLibrary on tablets and smart phones



## Step 1

Download the cloudLibrary app from your device's app store or from <http://yourcloudlibrary.com>.

Note: To install Cloud Library on Kindle Fire devices, follow the instructions at <http://www.yourcloudlibrary.com/index.php/en-us/get-the-app/kindle-fire>.

## Step 2

Connect to my library

Log in to the app using Washington County Library and your card number and PIN.

## Step 3

See *Featured Collections*, browse categories from the left menu, or search specific authors and titles by clicking the magnifying glass in the upper right corner.

## Step 4

BORROW

Tap the eBook you are interested in and tap the *Borrow* button.

HOLD

If book is not available, there will be a *Hold* button. If you want to be notified when your hold is available, tap *Settings* in the left menu, check the email notification box, and enter your email address.

## Step 5

READ

Borrowed titles, holds, and history will appear on the *My Books* screen.

Tap image of book to read.

## To Return eBooks Early

RETURN

Open cloudLibrary app. Access *My Books*. Tap the Return Books icon on the right, and then tap the *Return* button next to the book you wish to return.

## eBook Policies

- All customers of Washington County libraries with a valid library card may check out eBooks.
- Customers are limited to 10 titles at a time.
- eBooks are checked out for 21 days.
- You may have up to 10 holds at a time. An email is required to place a hold.
- When they become available, requested items are held for 72 hours.
