

# Get going with OverDrive on Kindle Fire



## Step 1

Download the OverDrive app from <https://app.overdrive.com> or the Amazon app store.



## Step 2

Open the OverDrive app. Follow the prompts to sign up using your library card number.

If you're under 13, select *I am under 13 years old* instead.



## Step 3

Tap *Add a Library* and search for Washington County Library. Tap your library, then tap Washington County Library.

## Step 4

Log into the library's OverDrive website with your library card number and PIN and borrow a title. You may place a hold on books currently checked out.

## Step 5

Under Menu, select *Sign In*, and then click on *Bookshelf*. Select *Choose a Format*, then *Kindle Book*.

Click *Get Kindle Book*, complete the checkout on Amazon's website, and send the book to your Kindle.

You may also tap *Read Now* to read the eBook right in your browser.

## To Return eBooks Early

If you downloaded the book, go to your Bookshelf and tap and hold on the book cover. Tap *Return to library*.

If you did not download the book, go to your Loans page and tap return under the book cover.

# Get going with OverDrive on Kindle eReaders



## Step 1

Go to the library's OverDrive website at <https://washington.overdrive.com>

## Step 2

Find a book, click *Borrow* and log into your account using your library card number and PIN. You may place a hold on books currently checked out.

## Step 3

Under *Sign In*, click on *Loans*.

Select *Choose a Format*, then *Kindle Book*.

Click *Get Kindle Book* and complete the checkout on Amazon's website. Send the book to your Kindle via Wi-Fi or connect your Kindle to your computer for USB transfer.

You may also tap *Read Now* to read the eBook right in your browser.

## To Return eBooks Early

Sign in to your Amazon.com account. Select *Manage your content and devices*.

Find the item to return and click the *Actions* button on left.

Select *Return This Book*. Select *Yes* to confirm.

## eBook Policies

- All customers of Washington County libraries with a valid library card may check out eBooks.
- Customers are limited to 10 titles at a time.
- eBooks are checked out for up to 21 days.
- You may have up to 10 holds at a time. An email is required to place a hold.
- When they become available, requested items are held for 72 hours. You may also choose to have a requested title checked out to you automatically when it is available.
- eBooks can be renewed if there are no other requests.
