

# Get going with cloudLibrary eAudiobooks



## Step 1

Download the cloudLibrary app from your device's app store or from <http://yourcloudlibrary.com>.

Note: To install cloudLibrary on Kindle Fire devices, follow the instructions at <http://www.yourcloudlibrary.com/index.php/en-us/get-the-app/kindle-fire>

## Step 2

Connect to my library

Log in to the app using Washington County Public Library and your card number and PIN.



## Step 3

Find audiobooks by looking for the blue headphones icon or by tapping Filters in the left menu and unselecting e-Books

## Step 4

BORROW

Tap the audiobook you are interested in and tap the *Borrow* button.

HOLD

If title is not available, there will be a *Hold* button. If you want to be notified when your hold is available, tap *Settings* in the left menu, check the email notification box, and enter your email address.

## Step 5

LISTEN

Borrowed titles, holds, and history will appear on the *My Books* screen.

Tap image of audiobook to download and listen.

*Note:* Depending on your connection speed, downloading could take awhile.

# Get going with cloudLibrary eAudiobooks

## To Return eAudiobooks Early

RETURN

Open cloudLibrary app. Access *My Books*. Tap the Return icon on the right, and then tap the *Return* button next to the book you wish to return. Confirm choice.

## eAudiobook Policies

- All customers of Washington County libraries with a valid library card may check out eAudiobooks.
- Customers are limited to 10 titles at a time.
- eAudiobooks are checked out for 21 days.
- You may have up to 10 holds at a time. An email is required to place a hold.
- When they become available, requested items are held for 72 hours.
